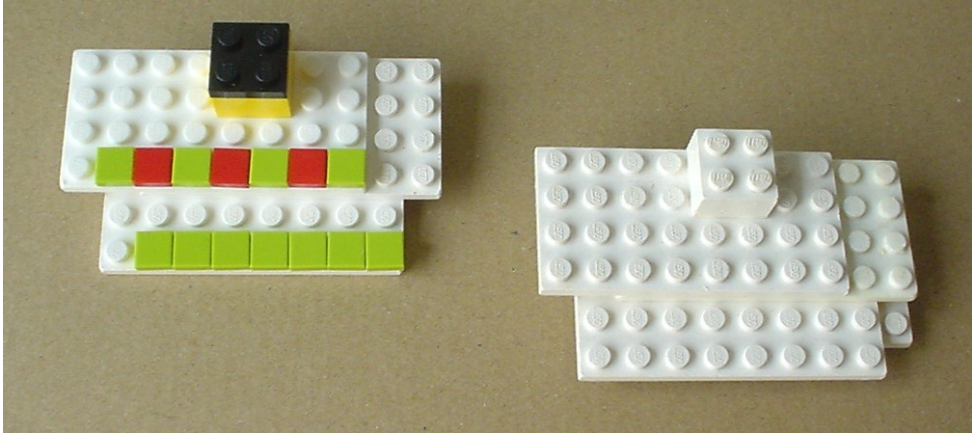


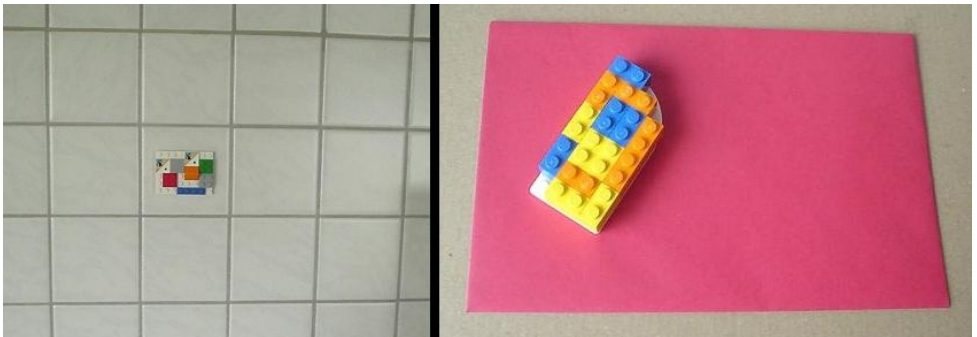
# Two Artists in Team: My Washing Machine and me
